ELIGIBLE GRANT APPLICANTS

Local agencies or non-profits are eligible grant applicants. Other groups can submit grants through eligible sponsors.

OTHER KEY INFORMATION

The SWFM (Prop 1E) grant utilizes statewide competition. Each grant application submitted is scored according to criteria and then the applications are ranked by score without regard to geographic location in the state. Only work performed after execution of the grant agreement will be eligible for reimbursement.

3. A subcommittee will screen the project.

The Bay Area Flood Protection Agencies

Association (BAFPAA) represents flood protection and stormwater entities and is a key participant in the **Bay Area Integrated Regional Water Management (IRWM) Group**. Prop 1E grant applications are due April 15th. To be eligible, your project must be listed in an IRWM Plan. See “Dates” at left for process and schedule for getting your project into the Bay Area IRWMP Plan.

ELIGIBLE PROJECTS

- Projects must be consistent with an adopted Integrated Regional Water Management (IRWM) Plan, which means projects must be included in an IRWM Plan or have been added to the implementation project list for an IRWM Plan according to established procedures (see left). **Projects added to the Bay Area IRWM Plan (BAIRWMP) through a screening committee process are considered to be “consistent” with the plan.**
- Designed to manage stormwater runoff to reduce flood damage.
- Consistent with the applicable Regional Water Quality Control Plan (Basin Plan)
- Cannot be part of the State Plan of Flood Control (projects located outside Central Sacramento – San Joaquin Valley are not part of the SPFC)
- Yield multiple benefits which may include one of the following elements:
 - Groundwater recharge
 - Water quality improvement
 - Ecosystem restoration and benefits
 - Reduction of instream erosion and sedimentation

Project proponents must provide specific project information to meet the grant application requirements. The Proposition 1E Proposal Solicitation Package (PSP) describes the attachments required for submittal. They are bulleted below.

- Project Work Plan
- Project Budget Information
- Project Schedule
- Monitoring, Assessment, and Performance Measures
- Economic Analysis – Water Supply Costs and Benefits/Flood Damage Reduction***
- Water Quality and Other Expected Benefits
- Cost and Benefits Summary
- Program Preferences
- Disadvantaged Community Assistance
- AB 1420 and Water Meter Compliance (only applicable to Urban Water Suppliers)
- Consent Form
