OTHER KEY INFORMATION

The Bay Area IRWM region has been accepted in the Region Acceptance Process (RAP) by DWR for Prop 84 funding. Total Prop 84 allocation for the Bay Area Region is \$138M (\$15-30M in Round 1). Projects deemed eligible will be evaluated and ranked after final grant guidelines are released.

SUBMITTING PROJECTS FOR INCLUSION IN THE BAY AREA IRWM PLAN

1. Complete an IRWMP Project Template. URL: <http://bairwmp.org/projects/submitting-a-project-to-the-bay-area-irwmp>
2. Submit template to: Projects@bairwmp.org
3. A subcommittee will screen the project and recommend whether to add to the IRWM Plan.
4. The Bay Area IRWM Coordinating Committee will vote on whether to add project to the plan.
5. Once added, additional information may be requested to prioritize projects for Prop 84 grant funding.

The Bay Area Integrated Regional Water Management Group represents water supply/quality, waste/recycled water, flood protection/stormwater, and watershed/habitat organizations of the 9 counties of the Bay Area. A proposal solicitation package for IRWMP projects under Prop 84 is anticipated to be released by Fall 2010. [This brochure will help you understand your project's potential eligibility.](#)

ELIGIBLE PROJECTS

Projects must be consistent with an adopted Integrated Regional Water Management (IRWM) Plan. This means that projects must be included in an IRWM Plan, the process for which is described in the box to the left.

Specific Goals of Prop 84 are:

- Include regional projects or programs (CWC §10544)
- Effectively integrate water management programs and projects within a hydrologic region
- Effectively resolve significant water-related conflicts within or between regions
- Contribute to attainment of one or more of the objectives of the CALFED Bay-Delta Program
- Address critical water supply or water quality needs of disadvantaged communities within the region
- Effectively integrate water management with land use planning Address statewide priorities

DRAFT Prop 84 guidelines provide a preference for projects that benefit Disadvantaged Communities (DACs) and projects providing for water conservation to meet a 20% reduction by 2020.

SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS

Project proponents must provide specific project information as described in the IRWMP Project Template to be considered for addition to the IRWM Plan. Project proponents should review the DRAFT Prop 84 Proposal Solicitation Package (PSP) that describes additional information that would be necessary for each project proposed for grant funding. Current regional priorities for this round include:

- Drought Relief & Water Conservation
- Green Infrastructure
- Water/Wastewater Recycling & Desalination
- Mercury & PCBs Risk Reduction
- Watershed & Ecosystem Restoration
- Floodplain Preservation & Flood Infrastructure Improvements
- Regional Outreach (for above items)
